## Use of Stepladder

The use of the Stepladder stored in the Hall is contingent on the following:-

1. Any person using the Stepladder must have read and understood the HSE “safe use of ladders and stepladders” and take note and observe the instructions on the side of the stepladder
2. Within the Hall it is may only be used as a stepladder i.e. it must not be leant against the walls. n.b. If used as a ladder:- a) the bottom of the ladder could slip b) the top of the ladder might damage the walls
3. When anyone is standing on the Stepladder, at a height greater than 6 feet, there should be someone at the base supporting the Stepladder. At lower heights you must make your own decision.
4. Before any use ensure there is no apparent damage to the Stepladder.
5. After use the Stepladder must closed and left safely in the cloak room annex.

I/we understand that the use of the Stepladder is at our own risk, are satisfied it is in good condition, suited for our intended use and will have read the safety information, detailed in 1 above, before using the Stepladder.
